This position will be responsible for the installation, modification, maintenance, service, and repair of electrical appliances, systems, and related electronic controls and devices by interpreting blueprints, manufacturers' specifications, and written and verbal instructions.

Accountabilities

Primary responsibilities will include:

- Install, maintain, repair, and modify industrial electrical wiring, equipment, and instrumentation in accordance with relevant codes and from blueprints, schematics and sketches.
- Complete preventive maintenance programs for electrical systems and manufacturing equipment.
- Troubleshoot production equipment (motors, switches, starters, and control panel wiring) using electrical and mechanical aptitude.
- Observe all safety rules, policies, and precautions, reporting and correcting unsafe work conditions. Submit safety ideas to Safety Committee Members. Complete required safety and regulatory training.
- Diagnose repairs and recommend process flow improvements to industrial control systems, and analog and digital applications.
