Accountabilities:

Primary responsibilities will include:

- Continually monitoring and recording areas of low productivity, and quality of lumber to meet quality standards and physical inventory.
- Recommends and assists the need for additional staffing.
- Make decisions about poor or questionable product quality and troubleshoot to correct deficiencies.
- Maintain recovery and downtime data for daily production reports.
- Provide employee training through both direct instruction and employee coaching.
- Evaluate employee performance and complete timely performance evaluations.
- Observe and provide employee coaching/warnings and discipline, while documenting all employee actions and training for the employee's permanent file.
- Approving, scheduling, and reviewing employee time cards to ensure accuracy and full coverage of shifts.

Qualifications:

- High school diploma or equivalent
- Must be able to understand and respond to verbal communication and instructions.
- Must have good computer skills.
- Must be able to work well with other employees and contractors for production/quality needs.
- Must be self-motivated to work with minimal direct supervision.
