Inventory Control Specialist

Biewer Wisconsin Sawmill is looking for a full-time **Inventory Control Specialist** to join our team in Prentice, WI. This position will monitor assigned inventory, and perform cycle counting to ensure that all material is properly accounted for. They will report product damage/concerns to the manager with a photo and description of the damage. Verify Agility/WMS inventory counts that will transition to Lumber Track in September.

Accountabilities:

Primary responsibilities will include:

- Cycle Count each finished inventory sub-location twice per month.
- Cycle Count WIP inventory once per week (Fridays or when production is not running).
- Account with the office manager to reconcile inventory regarding physical counts and receive inventory adjustment approval from the General Manager.
- Ability to research tag history to determine the root cause for inventory discrepancies, utilizing scan guns and computers.
- Able to navigate our system interface for adding/removing packs while verifying stock rotation.

Qualifications:

- High school diploma or equivalent.
- 90% working outside, 10% in the office working with the Office Manager.
- Ability to work without direct supervision.
- Basic mathematical skills.
- Being able to read and interpret documents such as safety rules, operating and maintenance instructions, and procedure manuals.
- Proficient computer skills.
